Message from the Director: Janet Boutin


As I rewrite our school's monthly newsletter, I realize much of this information could change again. For 51 years, our school has represented an environment of nurturing relationships and closely supporting young children. However, these times have broken up our daily routines and personal connections. Our school campus has been locked down, much anticipated school activities canceled and all school gatherings put off indefinitely. Through it all, our staff has been determined to keep their special connection with your child by planning fun remote learning activities. They have worked from home, held Zoom meetings and with no training and little time, managed to create wonderful lessons. Their lessons hosted "hello" videos from teachers and some Zoom sessions so classes could finally have chat time together. Our hope is these remote lessons will expand on your child's learning, keep the connection between child and teacher, relieve anxiety children might be experiencing and give you a break too.

When we return to school, we will need every family's help to keep your child healthy and the school open for business. First, we will be sending out a Family Travel Survey to track recent travel and determine temporary exclusion from school. Second, our campus will be open to children and staff only but, closed to everyone else to include parent/guardians, family, friends and all visitors. Before we return, be sure to speak positively to your child about their new drop off and pick up procedures. Practicing your special goodbye hug/kiss at home might be helpful for your child. Third, we will be taking every child's temperature before they enter campus. Please check your child's temp at home and always keep them home if they are sick. Fourth, do not send toys or other unnecessary items from home, they will be discarded. Our school and classroom items will continue to be disinfected. These are a few of the rules we must enforce to keep our school compliant of state health regulations. We will have other rules inside campus but, please know your child's health and safety are always our top priority.

In the meantime, please practice safe home quarantining so, your child will be ready to return to school and keep coming to school!
