In closing, I would like to thank our School, Church and community for 51 years of ongoing support. Thank you.



Important Information Regarding Medications

By law, if your child needs to take any medication, St. Peter's Episcopal School must abide by the follow-



Medications must:

- 1. Be in the original container;
- 2. Be labeled with the child's name;
- 3. Be labeled with the date (if prescription medicine);
- 4. Include directions to administer the medication; and complete and sign the School's medication form.
- 5. If prescribed, include the name of the physician prescribing the medication.

In addition, **PLEASE DO NOT put medicine in backpacks or lunch boxes.** Hand the medicine to the Early Bird teacher or child's teacher and SIGN the medication form. At the end of the day, please be sure to pick-up your child's medicine.
