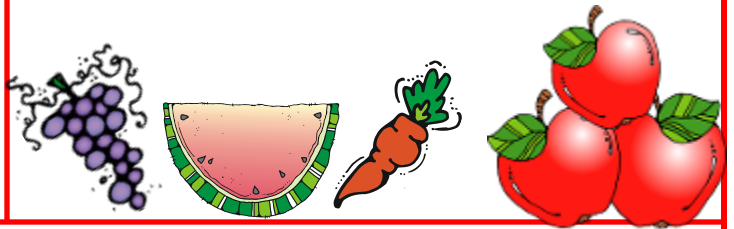


## "Growing Foods"

# Health and Safety At School

## Important Information Regarding Medications

By law, if your child needs to take any medication, St. Peter's Episcopal School must abide by the following:



### Medications must:

1. Be in the original container;
2. Be labeled with the child's name;
3. Be labeled with the date (if prescription medicine);
4. Include directions to administer the medication; and complete and sign the School's Medication Form.
5. If prescribed, include the name of the physician prescribing the medication.

In addition, **PLEASE DO NOT** put medicine in backpacks or lunch boxes. Hand the medicine to the teacher at carpool and **SIGN** the medication form.



## Please . . .

do not bring a sick child to school. Children must be "fever free" for **"72"** hours in order to return to school.

Regular hand washing keeps the germs away.



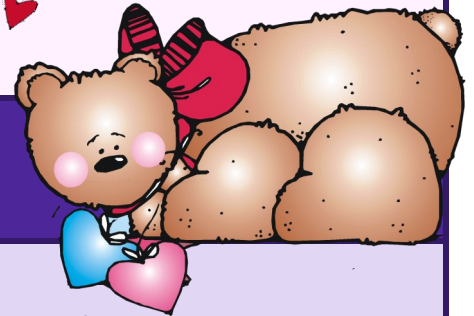

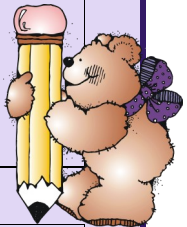
